**NIMA MARITIME SAFETY INFORMATION CENTER**

The National Imagery and Mapping Agency (NIMA) has restructured its Geospatial Information and Services Office (GI) to establish regional and functional Centers of Excellence. This reorganization will align GI with NIMA's mission, vision and strategic goals, enhance NIMA situational awareness, and improve direct customer interaction and service. Effective 04 December 2000, the NIMA Marine Navigation Department along with all other NIMA hydrographic components will be incorporated into the NIMA Maritime Safety Information Center of Excellence. This new organizational name will appear on all future editions of NIMA hydrographic products and will also be implemented on the NIMA Marine Navigation Website (<http://pollux.nss.nima.mil>). All current NIMA maritime safety information, charts and publications will continue to be made available as normal during this transition. **UNITED STATES COAST GUARD NAVIGATION INFORMATION SERVICE**

The United States Coast Guard Navigation Information Service (NIS), operated by the USCG Navigation Center, provides information for all radionavigation systems. The NIS is staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, providing information on the current status, effective policies, and general information for GPS, DGPS, and LORAN-C. The NIS also disseminates Safety Broadcasts (BNM); Local Notice to Mariners (LNM); and via e-mail subscription through the USCG Navigation Center website (<http://www.navcen.uscg.mil/gps/status/default.htm>), the latest Notice Advisory to Navstar Users (NANU). In addition, the NIS investigates all reports of degraded or loss of GPS, DGPS or LORAN service. **PUBLIC SALE OF NIMA NAVIGATION PUBLICATIONS TRANSFERRED TO THE GOVERNMENT PRINTING OFFICE (GPO)**

The National Imagery and Mapping Agency (NIMA) provides navigation publications for both civil and military customers. In the past, the printing of these publications was provided through the Government Printing Office (GPO) commercial printing contracts with public distribution accomplished via a cooperative agreement with the National Oceanographic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), Office of Aeronautical Charting and Cartography (now the FAA National Aeronautical Charting Office) and their selected resellers (sales agents). Effective 01 October 2000, NIMA has transferred the public sale of all new editions of NIMA navigation publications to the GPO, Superintendent of Documents (SuDocs) for both wholesale and retail purposes. All subsequent wholesale agreements for NIMA nautical publications must be established with GPO SuDocs.

**This change will not affect the distribution of NIMA nautical charts and the U.S. Notice to Mariners.**

All NIMA navigation publications offered for sale by the Superintendent of Documents may be ordered online, by phone or fax, or through the mail. Orders can be placed on the encryption-protected U.S. Government Online Bookstore (<http://bookstore.gpo.gov>), by phone (202-512-1800 from 7:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. Eastern standard time, Monday through Friday), fax (202-512-2250, 24 hours per day), or regular mail.
